An Overview of The Texas Clean Rivers Program



INTRODUCTION

The Texas Clean Rivers Program (CRP) is a state fee—funded program for water quality monitoring, assessment, and public outreach. The CRP is a collaboration of 15 partner agencies and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). It provides a framework and forum for managing water quality issues within a river basin, both locally and regionally, by coordinating the efforts of diverse organizations.

OVERVIEW OF THE CLEAN RIVERS PROGRAM PROGRAM GOAL

Maintain and improve the quality of water within each river basin in Texas through an ongoing partnership involving the TCEQ, river authorities, other agencies, regional entities, local governments, industry, and citizens. The program's watershed management approach will identify and evaluate water quality issues, establish priorities for corrective action, work to implement those actions, and adapt to changing priorities.



LONG-TERM PLAN

Objectives of the Clean Rivers Program

- Provide Quality-Assured Data to the Commission for Use in Water Quality Decision-Making
- 2) Identify and Evaluate Water Quality Issues
- 3) Promote Cooperative Watershed Planning
- 4) Inform and Engage Stakeholders
- 5) Maintain Efficient Use of Public Funds
- 6) Adapt Program to Emerging Water Quality Issues



PROGRAM TASKS

TASK 1: PROJECT ADMINISTRATION

Quarterly Progress Reports, cost accounting & reimbursement requests, conferences and training events, work plan development

TASK 2: QUALITY ASSURANCE

Basin-wide Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP) development and implementation, QAPP amendments, monitoring systems audits and laboratory inspections, data review/verification/validation

TASK 3: WATER QUALITY MONITORING

Planning and coordinating basin-wide monitoring (Coordinated Monitoring Schedule), conducting Routine, Systemic, and Special Study monitoring



PROGRAM TASKS

TASK 4: DATA MANAGEMENT

Manage a quality-assured water quality monitoring database, transfer of data to TCEQ's Surface Water Quality Monitoring Information System (SWQMIS)

TASK 5: DATA ANALYSIS & REPORTING

Conduct data analysis and develop reports (Basin Summary Report and Basin Highlights Report) that provide information to describe water quality and identify priority water quality issues for further investigation or action

TASK 6: STAKEHOLDER PARTICIPATION & PUBLIC OUTREACH

Basin Steering Committee & Meetings, public outreach & education, ANRA website updates, volunteer monitoring activities (Texas Stream Team)

TASK 7: SPECIAL PROJECTS

Special projects developed to address watershed-specific concerns (such as the collection of total and dissolved metals)


