









Fresh Water Mussels


- 2 native mussel species, the Louisiana pigtoe and the Texas heelsplitter, are currently candidates for federal protection.

TEXAS HEELSPLITTER (POTAMILUS AMPHICHAENUS) (HISTORICAL RANGE SHOWN IN RED HATCH)




LOUISIANA PIGTOE (PLEUROBEMA RIDDELLII) (HISTORICAL RANGE)










Alligator Snapping Turtles

- Found throughout East Texas, in all of the Neches River Basin.
- Currently listed as threatened in Texas and is a candidate for federal listing.
- Demographics and population size are not well understood in Texas so further research is needed.









Alligator Snapping Turtles

- Stephen F. Austin State
 University (SFA) is conducting a
 baseline study with Texas Parks
 and Wildlife Department (TPWD)
 to achieve a basic alligator
 snapping turtle demographics
 study for all of Texas.
- ANRA is working with TPWD to raise awareness about the status of alligator snapping turtles in Texas and will continue to look for ways to become more involved.
